- 3. How does God refer to Himself in Malachi 1:8, 9, 10, 11 and 14? What do we learn about Him from this?
- 4. In what five ways can we honor God?
- 5. What do Malachi 1:14; Psalm 10:16; 24:8; 84:3 and 95:3 tell us about our God?

Further Consideration

- 1. We see that at this time God's children, the Jews, were doing what was necessary to maintain their rituals, but their hearts were not in it. Have there been times in your life when this has been true? What is it like today for Christians who simply "go through the motions"?
